Retriever Labrador

Puppy (2,1)

1. Kent's Chyanhal Trevoise of Trewinnard - young black bitch with a feminine head and broad skull, neck muscular and clean, forequarters straight with good bone, deep chest, good spring of rib, typical otter shaped tail, angles correct front and rear moved well. Super temperament and sure to have a bright future RBOB, BP and PG2

Junior (2)

1. Kent's Chyanhal Trevoise of Trewinnard
2. Baker & Judd's Harpitts True Spirit – 13 month old black dog with broad skull, neck clean and set into well laid shoulders, good bone, deep chest with well sprung ribs. Moved well but unlucky to meet first today.

Graduate (4,2)

1. Baker & Judd's Harpitts True Spirit
2. Philpott's Rossacre Spangles - yellow bitch not as mature as the first. Kind expression good length of neck into well placed shoulders with well sprung ribs, good turn of stifle and hocks well let down. Correct double coat and tail set. Moved ok

Open Dog(3,2)

1. Baker & Judd's Harpitts Minnie Mack - dog exceling in breed type, broad head with kind expression, thick coat with dense undercoat. Deep chest, barrel ribbed and short coupled, angles correct front and rear with hocks well let down. Moved well straight front and rear. BOB
2. Philpott's Rossacre Keno - dog with kind expression, muscular neck into well laid back shoulders, straight front with sufficient bone, deep chest and short coupled. Moved ok

Retriever Golden

Puppy (3,1)

1. Pike's Charmagen Red Bunting at Trumpsgold -9 month old bitch with a balanced outline and excellent bone and substance. Very pleasing head and kind expression, straight front, angles correct front and rear, good depth to brisket, well sprung ribs moved well. BP, RBOB and PG4.
2. Smith's Endellion Olivia bitch - 11 month old bitch shorter coupled than first and not as mature. Pleasing feminine head, well ribbed, correct bend of stifle. Not as confident on the move as one.

Open Dog (4,2)

1. Bissell's Warrentor Tribute For Bisskids – balanced outline, masculine head, straight front with enough bone, well laid back shoulders, good spring of rib, angles correct front and rear, moved with drive and a better side profile than the second. BOB

2. Mace's Steval Choir Master at Telanjan - mature dog heavier all round than first, pleasing head and expression, straight front with good bone, short coupled with good bend of stifles, hocks well let down moved ok.

Flatcoated Retriever

Post Graduate (3,2)

1. Hayman's Tikkidui Showmans Dream - mature looking dog with a lot to like, kind expression, neck long, straight front, good depth of chest, well defined brisket and gradual spring of ribs, shown in excellent coat and condition, moved with enthusiasm. RBOB

Open (1)

1. Hayman's Lussac Thorn dog - masculine looking dog who presented a balanced picture stacked, correct shoulder placement, strong bone, deep chest with long ribcage, short loin leading to well muscled quarters, with hocks well let down, on the move enthusiastic and free flowing with good reach and drive BOB.

Hungarian Vizsla

Post Graduate (1)

1. Hunter's Tossneer Sophronia – 2 year old bitch with feminine balanced skull, muscular neck, straight front, shoulders of sufficient lay, enough depth to chest, ribs well sprung, moved ok with good head carriage. BOB

NSDTR

Post Graduate (4)

1. Vaughan's Katimba Malvasia of Valsannra - dog of super type with an appealing head, shoulders well laid back, forelegs straight and strong, deep chest with well sprung ribs, level topline, good turn of stifle and hocks well let down, double coated and straight of medium length, moved with good reach and drive and correct head carriage. BOB.
2. Ward's Melanitta Healstether - dog with masculine head and similar attributes to the first, straight front, well laid back shoulders, deep chest and good depth to brisket. Moved well but just preferred the overall outline of first on the move.
3. Hipkiss' Redaurora Comet's Christmas of Deltandamba

Open (4)

1. Hipkiss' Erikachen O'Ruadh for Deltandamba JW ShCM - overall well balanced dog with true toller head, good bone, straight front, shoulders well laid back, deep chest with ample spring of rib, shown in excellent coat and condition, moved well with good reach and drive. RBOB
2. Palfrey's Flushpoint Whata Accident for Melanitta ShCM – bitch almost 10 years old and shown in super coat and condition and certainly not showing her age. Typical head shape, shoulders well laid back, deep chest and well sprung ribs, hindquarters well muscled and hocks well let down. Moved with enthusiasm around the ring with the correct tail carriage.
3. Ward's Melanitta Healstether

Italian Spinone

Post Graduate (1)

1. Mortimer's Scodinzolare Perlescenti - pleasing orange young bitch up to size but with a balanced outline. Attractive feminine head with a nice eye and expression, presented in hard condition and with a correct harsh coat. Straight front with good bone. Muscular neck, good shoulders into a well ribbed body and correct topline, quarters well developed. Moved well.

Open (2)

1. Kruglow's Amberellie Adrianna - 6 year old bitch in super coat and condition, feminine head full of quality and balanced, correct shape and strong bone, neck short and muscular leading to well laid back shoulders with blades well set apart, chest broad deep with good ribbing, enough bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved well holding topline. BOB
2. Smith & McVittie's SC Ch Jaylynne Fabrizio ShCM – dog with a balanced head and kind expression, heavy in body with well sprung ribs, short muscular neck, straight front with good bone, well ribbed body and correct topline, quarters well developed. Moved well but preferred the overall outline of the first on the move.

Curly Coat Retriever

Post Graduate (1)

1. Edworthy's Maycourt Cadillac – outgoing dog with a balanced head shape, neck muscular leading to well placed shoulders, straight front with good bone, chest deep, with level topline, correct coat texture . Never really settled on the move today. RBOB.

Open (1)

1. Courtier's SH CH Maycourt Crimson Moon - bitch with super type, very feminine head, coat of the correct texture and free from woolliness. Forelegs straight with tight round feet, shoulders well laid back and muscular, chest deep with well sprung ribs, balanced angulation front and rear with depth throughout, moved ok but I would have preferred more drive. BOB

Weimaraner

Post Graduate (3,1)

1. Kerslake's Kuantan Cosworth - masculine dog standing well over his ground, masculine head but not overdone in any way. Clean in outline, super reach of neck, level topline and good finish to croup. Balanced angles both fore and aft and depth and strength to his body. Moved well with reach and drive holding his topline. BOB.
2. Goord's Indeski Reagan - bitch with pleasing head and lovely expression and eye, well laid back shoulders, good spring of rib, didn't seem to be enjoying her day today. RBOB

Open (2,1)

1. Kerslake's Kuantan Cosworth

German wirehaired Pointer

Post Graduate (1)

1. Harries' Dreggheda if I Were Single - bitch with a typical head for the breed and the correct amount of furnishings around eyebrows and beard. Neck strong, sloping shoulders, straight front with strong pasterns, deep chest and well muscled hindquarters. RBOB.

Open (1)

1. Harries' Myrna Loy - bitch with super type, and a balanced outline throughout, just lacked head furnishings of RBOB but overall coat wiry with a dense undercoat and harsh outer coat. Balanced angulation front and rear, straight front, deep chest, moved well. BOB

English Setters

Post Graduate (3,1)

1. Condron's Bumblecorn Rosalie at Covarney - bitch with kind expression, balanced head, correct ear set, neck long muscular and lean, front straight, chest deep and ribs well sprung, never really settled on the move today. RBOB
2. Masters' Bridgella's Lauren Bacall at Manchela - bitch as with the first never really settled on the move. Feminine head, clean neck, shoulders well set back, good spring of rib, hocks well let down, shown in excellent coat and condition.

Open (2,1)

1. Osman's Bournehouse Star Gazer at Marissolo ShCM - dog well presented in good coat, masculine head with defined stop and kind eye, strong clean neck into good shoulder, rounded bone, deep chest and good rib, level top line, good turn of stifle, moved soundly with correct tail carriage. BOB
