Open (3,0)

1. West's Ojons Ghost Rider De L'aige Dela Tournelle Shepailian – White Swiss Shepherd – 17 month male maturing well. Excellent bone, showing good breed type, finely chiselled head with slight stop, balanced front and rear and moved very soundly. Best Import Reg

2. Condrón's Khyannes Valence At Covarney – Braque D'Auvergne – 7 mth dog who was a lovely example of the breed. Showed a kind, gentle temperament, skull in proportion, long slightly arched neck, muscular shoulders, well angulated hindquarters. Moved out well. Best Imp Reg Puppy

3. Smith's Cuidado Yikes Y'all – Hungarian Pumi

Irish Wolfhound

PG (1,0)

1. Gregory's Braewisan Kallai At Killoughery – Young bitch, still a long way from maturity but lots to like. Feminine head, long, muscular neck, sloping shoulders, well sprung ribs, balanced front and rear. Moved out really well. BOB

O (1,0)

1. Gregory's Barrassy's Shooting star At Killoughery – Powerful male with great bone and plenty of body. Very sound on the move. Well angulated front and rear. Good depth of chest and length to body. RBOB

Ibizan Hound

O Dog (3,1)

1. Carter & Hozempa's Ch Amahte Runnin On Jamaican Time – 8yo boy who looks super for his age, fine, long skull with large erect ears. Long, muscular neck, steep shoulders, level topline, short coupled with a definite tuck up. Moved out well. BOB

2. Carter, Hozempa & Alenby's Afilador Ross Poldark – 6 month pup who was a bit overwhelmed today. Very much a baby and giving his handler a hard time. Difficult to assess him or his movement as he was somewhat unsettled. However, he shows a lot of promise.

O Bitch (4,2)

1. Carter's Afilador Room On The Broom – 3yo bitch with a lovely outline. Beautiful head and expression, long, clean neck, Good forechest, short coupled and correct slight hind angulation. Moved out well. RBOB

2. Carter's Afilador Amadora – Super 6 month bitch showing lots of character and breed type. Feminine head, large, erect ears, long neck, steep shoulders, level topline, which she held well on the move. Once she settled she showed good paces.

Dachshund Mini S/H

PG (5,1)

1. Poulrier's Auradach Alfred The Great – B/T dog showing lovely breed type. Conical shaped head, dark eye, long, muscular neck and good shoulder placement. Moderately long body and in super condition. Very sound on the move. RBOB

2. Tree's Keimantre Lola – Smaller type bitch, but still balanced. Well angulated front and rear, good body length and another good mover.

O (4,0)

1. Rudkin's Keydax Layla For Dynastydax – Beautiful B/T bitch who is very eye-catching. Super size and overall shape, which she maintained on the move. She is feminine but has good bone. BOB

Dachshund Mini L/H

PG (1,0)

1. Cox's Bronia Jelly Belly – 12 mth red bitch. Loved her feminine head and her expression. Sloping shoulders, level topline and slightly arched loin. Moved well away and back and held her outline on the move. BOB

Dachshund W/H

PG (2,0)

1. Phipps Bear Hound At Tufterslodge – Puppy bitch of good size and type. Body was unexaggerated, long and low. Well placed shoulders, prominent keel, plenty of bone and substance without being coarse. Powerful on the move. BP & RBOB

2. Clayton-Smith's Cairparavel Lilac Wine – Overall heavier type bitch but still very sound on the move. Stronger in head than the winner and more bone, but not coarse. Just preferred the type of 1.

O (4,1)

1. Clayton-Smith's Cairparavel Kiss From A Rose – Young bitch of a lovely size. Prominent keel, good depth of chest, plenty of length and strong hindquarters. Lovely head and expression. Moved very well. BOB

2. Phipps Grande Raven At Tufterslodge – 9 mth dog, masculine young boy, good head and long muscular neck. Balanced front and rear. Needs time to mature now.

Dachshund Mini W/H

PG (2,1)

1. Kilroy's Blackvein Cupid At Janacop – 9 mth dog, sturdy young boy, masculine head with a strong jaw. Moves ok but does need to drop his tail somewhat on the move as this spoils his overall outline. BP & BOB

## Basset Hound

PG (1,0)

1. Thexton's Barrenger Cadence – young bitch, just out of junior, shown in lovely condition, balanced angulation front and rear. Plenty of forechest and good ribbing. Held her shape well on the move. RBOB

O (2,0)

1. Thexton's Barrenger Harmony – Bitch of a good type, good bone and substance, typical head with a soft, kind expression, long, clean neck, well laid back shoulders. She moved very well and held her shape and topline as she went. BOB

2. Wilding's Nelgus Wild Jasmine – Shorter cast bitch than 1. But still good for bone and overall condition. Feminine head, slightly shorter in neck but shoulder placement was good. Moved well.

1. Adey's Caldcacre The Dazzler At Rubeusbay – 11 mth bitch, very feminine, liked her overall outline and she was shown in good condition. Well laid back shoulders, straight front and rear and short feet. BP & BOB

O(1,0)

1. Adey's Sufayre Angels Whisper At Rubeusay – 8 yo bitch with a typical head and expression. Really liked her body shape, long clean neck, moderate sprung ribs and a slight tuck up. Moved ok RBOB

## Beagle

O (5,4)

1. Adey's Timamso Suraya At Rubeusay – Smart young girl, feminine head and good depth to her muzzle. Slightly arched neck, body compact and sturdy. Moved well, using her tail as she went. BOB

## Hound Group

1. Trouton's Citycroft Grace Kelly Of Runnel – Whippet – This feminine young f/w girl has to be gone over to appreciate the breed qualities she has. She has a pleasing head and expression, her neck has good length with the desirable arch to it. Well laid shoulders, enough forechest, well sprung ribs and a good turn of stifle. She is so unexaggerated and correct for breed type. On the move she is sound away and back, covers her ground well and daisy clips as she goes. No hesitation to award her the group.

1. Harding's Kingsmist Miss Marple – 16 mth black bitch. Well bodied and a good overall shape. Well chiselled head, moderate stop and a gentle expression. Plenty of neck, good shoulders and well sprung ribcage. Moved ok. RBOB

2. Porter's Kingsmist Agatha Christie At Winsbrook – Litter sister to class winner, but not quite the substance. Similar remarks apply regarding her head and body but she was very unsettled on the move.

##### O (4,1)

1. Haeding's Kingsmist Lady In Black – 3yo black bitch. Another with a good body and covering. Balanced angulation front and rear with a well muscled second thigh. Moved ok but did hold her shape well as she went. BOB

2. Aleander's Fecimus Robin Banks – An older boy with a good masculine head. Well laid shoulder, excellent spring of rib, plenty of forechest and deep in brisket. Moved ok.

## Pointer

### PG (4,2)

1. Henshaw's Sharnphilly Vice Versa With Peteshe – 14mth b/w boy who is still a long way from maturity but so much to like about him. Super head with good chiselling, long clean neck, good bone throughout, good spring of rib and short couplings. Once he settled and his handler got to grips with him, he moved out really well. BOB
2. Osman's Fleurfield Hidden Depths Via Marissolo – 9 month o/w boy who is a good size but now needs to mature. Lovely head and expression, long muscular neck and enough angulation at the rear. Needs to settle in his front movement as this was a bit erratic and needs to drop his tail as this spoils his outline on the move. BPIB

### O (2,0)

1. Osman's Fleurfield Firethorn At Marissolo – B/w male with plenty of bone and substance. Won the class on his overall type and body shape. Good masculine head, well defined stop and soft expression. Does need to settle in his front movement though, which let him down in the challenge. RBOB
2. Henshaw's Penbro Under Pressure With Peteshe – o/w dog of a much finer type than the class winner. Beautiful head, plenty of detail and desired stop. Would just prefer a bit more angulation front and rear.

## Large Munsterlander

### PG (1,0)

1. Allen's Callixus Ursa Of Hartenziel – 2yo male who gave his handler a tough time due to his exuberance. Upstanding, masculine and well boned. Well laid shoulders and good turn of stifle. Very unsettled on the move so lost his body shape as he went. RBOB

### O (2,1)

1. Disney & Whiting's Sh Ch Wonglepong Will's Faramir – Fully mature boy, who won on his type and superior movement. Another dog making life hard for his handler. Excellent bone and shown in super condition. Balanced angulation front and rear. BOB

## Gordon Setter

### PG (4,1)

1. Allen's Black Mystery U Got The Look For Hartenziel – 15 mth male well bodied and in super condition. Masculine head with good depth showing an intelligent expression. Good outline, with plenty of ribbing and muscular hindquarters. Once he settled he moved well. BOB
2. Passmore's Beechlake Sea Of Love – Young bitch who was a much finer type than the class winner. Liked her head and expression. She has a well laid shoulder and good forequarters. Unfortunately, she was losing her shape on the move.

3. Green's Marshmoor White Lightning

O (4,3)

1. Macdonald's Graylacier Grand Illusion – 6yo male with an excellent head and expression. Plenty of depth to his body, good bone and feet. When he was stacked he was slightly lifting his topline and was similar on the move. Slightly weak behind but overall a powerful dog. RBOB

Cocker Spaniel

JR (3,0)

1. Green & Brain's Cachel Pop The Question To Meloneras – 11 mth blue roan bitch who is eye catching but fully appreciated when you go over her. Feminine head with a sweet expression, sloping shoulder, strong, compact body, well sprung ribs and level topline. Movement was spot on. Well handled and presented. BPIB, PG1 and delighted to see she went RBPIS.

2. Meaker's Kalispell Calamity Jane At Meakwood – 11 bitch, another lovely type but not quite the angulation of the class winner. Super head, long, clean neck, excellent body and moved well.

3. Miller's Eddeswarren Temptress

PG (4,0)

1. Masters Manchela Lady Million – B/w bitch who although she is very flashy and superbly presented, she is also well made underneath her coat. Super shoulders and balanced hindquarters, Feminine head with a distinct stop. She excels on the move with her sound paces and her excellent forward reach. BOB

2. Meaker's Meakwood Precious Pearl – B/R slightly shorter coupled bitch. Another very sound mover. Typical head with good chiselling. Muscular neck and a strong, compact body.

3. Smith's Meakwood East N'Rose

O (5,2)

1. Parkhouse' Sandaluga Magic spell For Shivani – Black female with a slightly stronger head with good detail. Short, compact body, level topline which she maintained on the move. RBOB

2. Ratcliff's Withiflor Blubeau – 7yo male of a larger type, masculine head, good angulation front and rear, level topline with a gentle slope. Moved very soundly.

PG (3,0)

1. Best's Amblelight Ophelia – 2yo bitch with good bone, body and substance. Long clean neck, well sprung ribs and muscular loin. Moved ok.
2. Dimond & Boumonte's Islanza Out Of The Blue At Roxdale – Rather fine puppy dog, who needs to develop in bone and body. Head still needs time, good clean neck, well sprung ribs. Moved ok. BPIB

#### O Dog (1,0)

1. Attwood's Ir Sh Ch Kylowen Drym – 4yo with a super head and expression. Well bodied, strong and muscular, slightly arched loin, would prefer slightly more front extension but otherwise a sound mover. BOB

#### O Bitch (3,1)

1. Dimond & Boumonte's Roxdale Sunday Lovers – Feminine, lighter boned girl. Super head and neck, good overall length, well coupled. Very sound on the move. RBOB
2. Attwood's Kylowen Demelza – A pleasing girl but slightly shorter on the leg. Good angulation front and rear. Feminine head, clean neck and good ribbing.

#### AVNSC Gundog Open (1,0)

1. Sweet's Bondadosa Beach – SWD – 4yo brown dog who commanded attention. Strong head with parallel planes, slight stop, expressive eyes, muscular neck, well sprung ribs and level backed. Angulation was moderate with well let down down hocks. On the move, he was very sound with his brisk action and powerful rear drive. BAVNSC Gundog and pleased to award him Gp1 in a very strong group.

1. Cocker Spaniel
2. Kent's Chyanhal Trevoise Of Trewinnard - Labrador Retriever- Strongly built, short coupled bitch, broad skull with a defined stop, clean, powerful neck, well laid back shoulders, barrel ribs. Super otter tail. Covered the ground well as she went.

4. Pike's Charmegan Red Bunting At Trumpsgold – Golden Retriever – Symmetrical and balanced young bitch, broad skull with a powerful muzzle, good length of neck, Straight in foreleg and well laid shoulders, level topline which she held on the move. Good free striding action.

AV Gundog Veteran (13,6)

1. Attwood's Ir Sh Ch Moorash Lady Ygraine Of Kylowen – WSS – 8yo bitch who was in super condition. Feminine head and soft expression, muscular neck, Good bone throughout and super spring of rib. Correct length of leg and a pleasing outline. Moved very soundly.

2. Ward's Flushpoint Whata Aristocrat At Melanitta – NSDTR – 9yo compact dog, well muscled throughout. Broad, wedge shaped skull, clean neck, well laid shoulders, deep chest and well sprung ribs. Super mover, with good reach and drive.
