I would like to say a huge thank you to the Secretary and committee for this wonderful opportunity to judge some lovely Hound breeds. Although there were some absentees, there was also a great presence in other breeds, giving me good quality and depth to judge. Thank you to those exhibitors who entered under me, it was a real pleasure to judge all dogs. Finally thank you to my wonderful steward Trevor!

Ibizan Hound

My first time doing this breed and it was an absolute pleasure. Handlers and dogs could not have been nicer and made this appointment an honour.

Open Dog (4, 1 absent)

1st & RBOB – Carter & Hozempa's CH AMAHTE RUNNING ON JAMAICAN TIME JW ShCM – A strong Male of excellent type. In his absolute prime at 5 years and it showed with stunning movement. Right at the top end in terms of height but completely in proportion and well-muscled throughout. Masculine head with expressive almond shaped eyes. Large ears correctly set on his head of equal lengths. Line of the ears lead to a strong neck and correct shoulders. Dominant breast bone, with the chest suitably distanced from the elbow and suitably tucked up. Level topline leading to a well-constructed rear. Rear Legs very strong in bone and length showing plenty of drive on the move.

2nd – Carter's AFILADOR THUNDERBOLT – A pleasantly shaped 3 year old male of less size than winner and rich in colour. A well-proportioned male with a typical head and expression. Was very naughty today and did not seem to settle very well, on first laps and upon assessment, but could feel quality. Handsome masculine expression with a stunning eye. Correct fine head and in proportion with body. Typical ears, nicely arched neck leading to a good front. Level topline with good tuck up. Pleasant rear construction with plenty of muscle for working. A fine specimen.

3rd – Carter & Channon's AFILADOR MOONLIGHT SHADOW ShCM

Open Bitch (4, 1 absent)

1st BOB & BPIB – Carter's AFILADOR ROOM ON THE BROOM – This Bitch really took my eye, completely full of herself and loving every moment in the ring. Despite only being 10months old I felt this bitch was exactly what I was looking for in an Ibizan. Lovely outline in profile, really drove round the ring, showing her to be in proportion and very well balanced. Fine feminine head, of equal lengths. Her eyes were full of expression. Ears were very active, with a nicely arched, lean neck following. Typical front shoulders of good angulations. Good length of leg and straight fronted. Chest not too deep, with straights ribs and plenty tuck up towards rear. Not overly angulated at the rear with a good muscle and was straight when leading away.

2nd - Carter's DIECISIETE MANDARINA AT AFILADOR ShCM – 11year Bitch who is a testament to the breed, solid throughout. I am of no doubt this lady could still work today at 11, due to her excellent condition. Fine head with a nicely coloured eye, good strong Jaw. A good set of ears and a neck of good proportions. Well legged and straight with good flat ribbing of nice length, good tuck up. a good topline leading to a well-constructed rear. Nicely arched feet.

3rd - Carter & Channon's AFILADOR A HINT OF JASMINE

Dachshund Miniature Smooth Haired

A lovely class to judge and difficult decisions were made. Really loved my Best Puppy who I was pleased went on to win Puppy Group 1.

Open (6, 1 Absent)

1st & BOB – Thomas's ROYALDACH'S AUTHORISED QUEEN JW ShCM - A very pretty black and tan bitch with pleasant outline and pleasure to go over. Thought she covered the ground well despite the difficult surface. Natural feminine expression and a head of good lengths and in proportion with her body. Strong jaw and eyes that were not too prominent and of good size. Ears were board and well set. Excellent neck leading to well laid muscular shoulders. Good prominent chest bone and dimples. Lovely broad front feet, with strong nails. Rib cage, nicely rounded and not too deep, giving plenty of room for the internal organs. Good topline and nice undercarriage leading to a well constructed rear. Well-muscled hind legs with appropriate width and moved with drive.

2nd & BP - Rudkin's DYNASTYDAX PETER PAN – 6 month old Dog, for me one for the future and really challenged first place here, despite his age. A beautiful deep red colour. Moved very convincingly and settled nicely. Lovely outline. Strong head all in proportion and of good length. Good eye and expression too. Ears were in proportion but broad and set well on the skull. Jaw was correct and strong. Muscled neck leading to good shoulders. Well laid and of good substance. A strong chest also. Very well ribbed, great shape, full of room and of good length. Lovely topline and strong loin. Rear legs were well constructed, and nicely broad and well muscled.

3rd - Rudkin's DYNASTYDAX Tiger Lilly

Afghan Hound

Open

1st & BOB – Small's GARAMOND SPICE BERRY JW ShCM – Great to hear she went on to take Hound Group 1 and Reserve Best in Show and very well deserved too. A Black 3 year old bitch with cream furnishings, who is coming into her prime. Lovely overall outline and moved well in profile. On approaching her head was very typical with a nice stop, long features and excellent bite. Deep dark eye, well placed. Ears were of good length and correct. She carried her head proudly on a neck of good length. A well laid shoulders and nicely muscled. Good straight front, carried close to the body, and a lovely depth of chest. Straight front leading to correct pasterns and large feet. Her ribs were nicely sprung and a good level topline, with lovely example of a saddle, leading to a short but muscled loin. Her hind quarters were nicely put together giving her powerful drive, with a good bend of stifle and low set hocks.

Harsh coat, compact feet, nice roach to back, and moved out well. BoB. G3. 2 Bassett & Cornwall's Essenceera Kukulkan. 9 month old puppy with a little growing to do, but many of the attributes of 1. Sound and solid young boy, who showed well and moved with purpose. BP. PG2. 3 Hunter's Kibyghan My Girl..

O (5,2) 1 Sidwell's Beaufrogz Beyond Beauty. 2 Bassett & Cornwall's Essenceera Kukulkan. 3 Hunter's Stonepit Domino at Kibyghan.

Chow Chow

O (6,4) 1 Cummins and Rogers Dragonsway Tom Thumb. Well built 14 mths old dog in good coat, and with nice dark pigment. Balanced head, with small upright ears well set, clear eyes, and good bite. Tail set well over back and correct topline, tight feet, and altogether nicely shaped. Moved well, and showed impressively today, and deserved his success in the Group. BoB, G1. 2 Cummins Dragonsway Cinderella.

Tibetan Spaniel

G (6,2) 1 Hirstwood's Colour Me Happy. 18 mth old dog in excellent condition, and full coat. Good length and level back, with a typical head, nice shape to muzzle, dark oval eyes, correct dentition, and well set pendant ears. Small neat feet, nicely feathered, with a high set tail, well carried both standing and on the move. Alert and expressive, and deserved his success today against some very nice examples. BoB 2 Quest's Lobsang Fame's Little Day at Chenrezi. BP. PG3. 3 Hirstwood's Quintrelle Colour Me Pretty

O (5,2) 1 Quest's Chenrezi Another Love JW ShCM. A good class, and close between all three very nice bitches. Just a little more quality overall in this bitch, in full luxuriant coat, and showing with confidence. Attractive head and expression, slightly lighter in pigment, with dark oval eyes and well placed and well feathered ears. Neck short and strong, on well laid shoulders, and nice shape to back and tailset. Moved well, and pushed hard for BoB. 2 Quest's Chenrezi Summer Breeze JW ShCM. 3 Hirstwood's Yllastel Suki Takes It Off for Quintrelle.

Shih Tzu

O (1,0) 1 Puleston's Daltricia Thana at Shanuleas. Stood alone, but a good quality grey/black bitch in full coat of good length and texture. Attractive chrysanthemum look to the head, with good pigment and dark eyes. Strong laid back shoulders, and nice length and shape to back, with a deep chest. Plumed tail carried well over back and moved smoothly, keeping shape well. BoB

Miniature Poodle

O (4,0) 1 Todd's Alexhian Expecially For Me. Lovely mature black, showing with that little bit of arrogance which catches the eye. Nicely cut full coat, with a deep chest and neat tuck. Short back, high set tail, and arched feet. Balanced head, with good shape to the muzzle, clear almond shape to the eyes, and with dark pigment. Straight front and moderate angulation, and moved with purpose.BoB 2 Hosking's Tarquas Strut My Stuff. PG4. 3 Hosking's Secret Whisper.

Keeshond

O (3,1) 1 Hill's Plymkees Cool Dude ShCM. A mature 5 year old boy in excellent condition and full coat. Compact and squarely built, with a well balanced head. Typical small ears , dark pigment, and dark almond shaped eyes. Luxuriant ruff, nice arch to neck on sloped shoulders, and straight front. High set tail, plumed over back, and good feathering all round. Moved briskly and with good drive. BoB.
2 Baker's Neradmik Boy Next Door.

O (9,1) 1 Luckman's Tawvale Winton. Very nice eye-catching Japanese Spitz, in excellent coat and condition. Attractive dark pigment set against clean white coat, with correct shape to head, pointed muzzle, oval eyes, scissor bite, and small, high set ears. Nice deep chest beneath a luxuriant coat, and altogether an attractive square appearance. Attentive and bright, and moved well. Best AVNSC.

Good angles front and rear, allowing her to move with a spacious easy gait. She held her topline on the move. This bitch is not over done in any way, she won her class with ease. A lovely example of the breed. BOB

2, Busby. Eirik AV Rottenhaller. 17 month old black and gold male. Top size of good proportions. Lovely all male head. Correct angles fore and aft, a little unsettled at first but he showed lovely free spacious gait once he'd stopped playing around, his tail was at times a little 'gay' due to his exuberance, but he is still a baby. Needs time to mature on, but everything is in the right place and once mature I'm sure he will be one to watch.

Nice angles, short coupled cobby body, lovely straight topline which she held on the move, finished off by a nicely set tail with a double twist. BP

2. Lee, Glenalva I'm Meryl Tuckenhay. Fawn 10 month old bitch, very different type to 1, lovely expression with good pigment, longer cast in the body. She was very unsettled both on the table and when moving which made her hard to assess. She is one who needs time to mature.

Graduate 1 (4 abs)

Wills Hugapug Just Ella. Stood alone, 3 yr old fawn bitch, gorgeous feminine pansy face with neat ears, good pigmentation. Short cobby body with level topline which she held on the move, finished with a good tailset. Moved well.

Open 1 (3abs)

Wills, Hugapug Nutmeg. 18 month old pale fawn bitch. Exquisite expression, naughty dark eyes so typical of the breed. Lovely dark pigment, neat ears. Straight front legs with lovely width and depth of chest, well developed cobby body with super straight topline finished off with a high set tail. Very

correct angles which allowed her to move around the ring with soundness and purpose. Stood alone but a worthy winner, no hesitation in awarding her BOB .

Two very promising bitches who I liked for type, substance and temperament. 1 showed very well and had good proportions and outline, pretty head, good tail set and carriage and positive mover. Pleased to see she went onto win the utility puppy group – well done. 2 & RBOB Edens' Dalens Bethany Char. 3 Jackson's Aphadel Can't Buy Me Love. O 1 D A Spot of Trouble. 2 D Bethany Char.

AVNSC HOUND – O 1 & BNSC Ashton's Bribiba Cuan Ghra of Madalinca, Irish Wolfhound. Full of breed type, plenty of substance, dark eyes, straight front, good depth of chest and moved smoothly and accurately in all directions with a strong rear, a nice prospect. 2 & RBNSC McConville's Ottaryx Ouzel, Otterhound. 3 McConville's Ottaryx Mulberry.

AV HOUND – P 1 Rudkin's Dynastydax Peter Pan. Min Smooth Dachs. A super puppy who is developing nicely, appealing head with nice eye shape and rich colour, ears were expressive in use, long neck leading into a firm level topline which remained strong on the move. 2 Ashton's Madalinca Spring Creena. Irish Wolfhound. 3 Rudkin's Dynastydax Tiger Lily. Min Smooth Dachs.

AV HOUND – V 1 Small's Metewand Mamabula, Afghan Hound. In superb condition, coat is long and fine and she looks half her age, holding her head high and in that correct dignified manner, she moves with a spring in her step but so effortless, a real credit to her owner 2 Carter's Diecisiete Mandarina at Afilador, Ibizan Hound.

HOUND GROUP: 1 Small's Garmond Spice Berry JW ShCM, Afghan. Have judged this beautiful girl around 18 months ago where she took BOB in a quality breed entry and won the hound group under me. She has blossomed into a gorgeous typy Afghan oozing breed type from her oriental expression right down to her ring in her tail. She makes a superb balanced picture in the stack with laid back shoulders but strong front angulation, long neck, deep chest, firm back and powerful quarters with good width. She floats around the ring with style and accuracy and the overall picture is finished off with a correct fine and long coat that has been groomed to a high standard. G2 Irish Wolfhound. G3 Ibizan Hound. G4 Beagle. HOUND PUPPY GROUP – 1 Min Smooth Dachs. 2 Ibizan Hound. 3 Beagle.

Best hound reserve BOB – Otterhound, who got better and better the more he came into the ring, made a strong balanced outline and was an excellent mover.

FINNISH LAPPHUND – G 1 and RBOB Treasure's Lapinlumon Pilvipouta for Infindigo. Full of character and with a super temperament, she has a nice head with good size erect ears that were set well and used expressively, stood on strong legs and with good width to front, well ribbed and body slightly longer than height, has a good tail set and carriage, was carrying a bit too much weight for my taste and her coat was a bit wavy. O – 1 and BOB Treasure's Infindigo Riemu Emmi ShCM. Very attentive and lively, super ear set and shape, nice expression, strong forelegs but could do with more width of front, good for body proportions, excellent depth of chest and well ribbed, firm in back, moderate rear angulation and strong pasterns, moved with plenty of reach and drive. 2 Treasure's Tabanyaruu Karuselli Miika.

AUSTRALIAN SHEPHERD – O 1 and BOB West's Love Story of Fender Song for Shepalian. It was close between 1 and 2, little to separate these flashy litter

sisters. Both have attractive heads, good for shape and are balanced with medium well set triangular ears, good lay back of shoulder, well bodied up and powerful rear, stood on sturdy legs and tight feet. Just preferred the free movement of 1. 2 seemed to look a little stiff in her front assembly on the move. 2 and RBOB Cousins' Love In a Mist of Fender Song for Moortime JW. 3 West's Amberslade Michigan at Shepalian CDEX UDEX.

SAMOYED - G 1 and BP Willcock's Blossom Rain Moonlight Song of Dynar. Full of life and showing typical 'smiling' expression, good pigment, good head and tail carriage on the move, coat growing nicely and presented in clean condition, showed and handled very well. O - 1 and BOB Argyle's Elygra Ice Knights Legacy. A mature dog in excellent coat and condition with a very striking head and typy expression, very good dark pigment and good width of head and strong muzzle, stood soundly on strong well feathered feet, good spring of rib and firm in back, good rear angulation, tail carried highly and moved accurately in all directions. 2 & RBOB Parker & Sprout's Icemount Ky Luck Be A Lady. 3 B R M Song of Dynar.

ROUGH COLLIE - O 1 & BOB Wilson's Callahorn's Untouched Horizon at Valleyhaven. Good body size, appealing head, good width and sweet expression with sensitive tipped ears and overall in proportion to body, straight front, moderate bone, made a nice outline in the stack, moved with purpose, a little untidy when moving away but very expressive in head. 2 & RBOB Patman's Pick Pocket Via Samhaven. POLISH LOWLAND G - 1 & BP Burdett-Coutts & Cousins-Brown's Dobrany Dorianblue Odyssi. Gorgeous puppy who was friendly and a real handful for the handler, excellent pigment, strong round feet, good proportions and size, coat developing nicely. O - 1 & BOB Sweet's Chrevle Zophire. Made a good outline and balanced shape, excellent pigment, head of good size and shape, lively and friendly temperament, accurate movement going for and aft, she won this class on showmanship where she also stood solid and four-square. 2 & RBOB Burdett-Coutts' Dewiza Kontekst at Chrevle.
