RBOB

2yrs with an obviously feminine head; well coupled & active with width & depth; breadth over loin; gd bone & feet; out of coat & came on weaker in front.

7.5yrs b; such a gorgeously feminine head of length & moulding; expressive eye; but way too much "lumber" now that shortened her up from neck & beyond so as to adversely affect her overall performance.

18m blk d truly bred in the purple & it showed; quality, wedge-shaped head of correct proportions with parallels; oblique, oval eye; small, well set ear; clean neck; firm front; has forechest & depth; level & of correct length; breed specific coat; can still strengthen moving away but circuited with easy, strong stride; one to watch. BOB

7yrs d; quality, handsome head scoring in eye & ear; just a little overbuilt now; short-coupled & squarish; well angulated; well muscled thigh; gd bone & feet, well padded; well coated & turned out; came on a little elbowy but gaited freely with energetic, long strides. BOB
