Many thanks to this Committee for the invitation and to the exhibitors for such a lovely entry. For me every appointment is an honour and the exhibits come first. With such a sizeable entry I judged without a break to ensure exhibitors were not kept waiting and my young steward was very good in keeping my ring going with the minimum of delays. I had some rather lovely hounds to assess and a very strong stakes class. I have added a few more to my lists to follow their progress! Group winner was the Irish Wolfhound. Upstanding and with super presence. Easily covered ground despite his size. Group 2 was the Whippet. Third went to the Beagle and fourth place was the Smooth Dachshund. Puppy Group was topped by the PBGV. Cheek on legs and his movement and personality helped him to this place. PG2 was the Beagle. Third place went to the Long Haired Dachshund and fourth to the Whippet AFGHAN PG (1) Webb's Madelion Lady Dementer. Feminine and balanced in outline. Excellent headshape, cheeky attitude long neck, good layback of shoulder, nicely boned and with big padded feet. Immature but lots of promise, BOB BP PBGV P(1) Fordham Soletrader Field Marshall. What a little smartie. Loved him. Only 7 months and such a confident attitude. Lovely head, dark eye with cheeky expression. Good front construction, Nicely boned. Plenty coat. Firm body and good ribs. He messed around on the move playing to his public but when settled he could really reach and drive. Covered the ground with ease. BOB BP and BPIG O (1) Fordham Elsie Monsieur Oakley Mature and well coated up. Another with a typical head, Dark eye, Deep chest. Muscular neck, good ribbing, level topline, good feet. Not quite so tidy in front coming towards me. Possibly the surface today. RBOB. BEAGLE P (1) Breeze Parkebreeway Buckle Bunny. Promising puppy 10 months. This girl had a typical beagle head. Good ears, Loved the expression of mischief. Straight front with round bone to feet, Good layback, neat elbow, good spring of ribs. Level topline. Nicely angulated behind and moved well on good feet. BP RBOB Jnr (3,1) Adey Boskenna Enchanted at Rubeusbay Attractive head, dark eye calm expression Good ear set Strong neck neat front' held a level topline and had firm hindquarters Preferred the slightly stronger movement of this one moving easily on good feet. 2 Oak Michelroy Boston Tea Party by Floridgebay Balanced but preferred the bone on winner, Neatly made front, Good length of neck, shoulders laid back, topline level and muscled quarters. Less positive on the move. Grad (1) Breeze Parkbreeway Wyseman JW Solid T/w boy. Very balanced. Good bone and feet, tidy front, Sturdy body. He held his topline and used his hindquarters well. O (3) 1 Quantick's Parkebreeway Rumour JW Liked this tri dog. His head was correct. Ears sitting nicely and enough stop. There was depth to his muzzle, strong neck, Neat elbow, good round bone, Nicely bodied up with good ribs. Plenty muscle tone. Firm quarters and moved comfortably to win BOB. Gp 3 2 Hoopers Davricard Jacobean at Torbers. Another with lots to like but I preferred the depth of chest on the winner. Good head and expression, Neat front. Nice ribs kept level topline. On the move was very slightly wide behind. 3 Breeze's Dufosee Honestly of

Parkebreeway. BLOODHOUND O (2,1) Westron's Farlap Kaleb Old fashioned and nicely balanced. Noble head, Dark eyes, Ears set on low and of good length. Wide Nostril. Good body bone and feet, Deep chested and well angulated front and back. Eye catching. BOB

DACHSHUND L/H PG Cooper, Laird & Hendrew's Bronia Leonardo. (Not in catalogue) This was a lovely exhibit and the sire and dam could be easily guessed. Well coated puppy. Good front, chest deep and sits well in crook, Good bone and feet. Neck flows into well laid shoulder. Good topline and hindquarters. Slightly naughty and not concentrating today but a very nice boy who could do well.

DACHSHUND Min L/H PG (3,1) 1 Bater Donnydax Run the Avenue for Jarletts Correct head shape Neatly made front. Tight feet, Good length to body and nicely rounded hindquarters BOB BP 2 Westaway Minard Whispering Angel at Treranch A pretty one with a lovely expression, dark eye, tidy front with good feet. Well coated and firm quarters. Not so positive on the move today. O (3,1) Bater All For Show Close choice for me but the winner just had slight more length to its neck giving a more elegant outline. Otherwise both had neat fronts, Tight elbows, Ribs go well back and help keep the topline on the move. Firm behind with low hocks and moved ok. RBOB 2 Westaway Abbilis Maleficent at Treranch Another very pretty with similar attributes to winner. Tidy front Good length, Level topline and moved ok.

DACHSHUND S/H PG (2) 1 Rycrofts Raajputs Dancer Divaa with Tresensara JW What a lovely feminine B/T. Super front and rear, Deep chest, plenty keel sitting comfortably in the front assembly. Ribbing was deep and lengthy, good feet, bone body and moved well keeping that topline level on the move. RBOB 2 Parker's Malpaspups Coco at Zorionadax Pretty head, calm expression, Lengthy neck and well laid shoulders, Slightly shorter in body than winner but well muscled. Would prefer shorter hocks but moved well enough in the class holding a good topline.

O (3) Almaznyi Laretz Ershalaim at Devondax (Imp Rus) Close decision here between first and second. Both had correct heads, neat fronts. Good ribbing and plenty body, bone and nicely padded feet. I just preferred the elegance of the neck on the winner. This just completed the picture. They covered the ground easily using strong low hocks. Another day I could have changed them round BOB Gp 4

DACHSHUND Min S/H PG (2) 1 Small's Marvale Golden Oriole for Devondax Very pretty with lovely outline. Typical Head, eyes dark and good ear set. Neat front. Good length to neck. Sturdy body, good bone and feet. Moved well RBOB. 2 Woodhouse Kenleaps Moon Hero Was unsettled at first on the table and not too happy at first. It had good bone and feet, nice angulation behind But came towards me a touch wide. However it was in a few more classes and gradually settled more. Needs time. L (2) 1 Small's Glynlythe's Heirloom for Devondax Such a pretty girl. Loved her head and expression Tidy front, well boned legs and tight feet. Neck set into well laid shoulders, good body and firm behind. Enough clearance and moved well. 2 K Moon Hero. O (3) 1 Small's Bronia Gustav of Melriding. Very nice type, Excellent head, Good in front with keel well supported. Good layback of shoulders and topline held level at all times. Super body condition. Lengthy ribs and muscled hindquarters. Enough clearance and

covered ground well BOB 2 K Moon Hero 3 Poulier's Auradach Alfred the Great DACHSHUND W/H PG (1) 1 Parker's Vixendachs Tatiana Although unsettled on the stack she moved well. Feminine aspect. Good head with kind eye. Neat front, Elbows fitted well, good ribs. Topline settled on the move and she used her hindquarters well. RBOB O (1) Parker's Vixendax Tornado Brother to previous class winner. Handsome and with a balanced outline. Typical head with dark eye, good earset, strong jaw. Good length of neck. Level topline. Lively on the move BOB.

DACHSHUND Min W/H O (2) 1 Kilroy's Rozelle Rosalie at Janacop JW Nice outline both standing and on the move. Attractive head, expressive eye, good ear set. neat front. Deep chest. Good length to body and nicely rounded quarters. Good bone tight feet. BOB 2 Kilroys Janacop Sweet Child of Mine 11 months old and with some maturing to do. Cheeky expression, Typical head, good length of neck, level topline, good ribbing and hindquarters. Just needs to tighten in front and was not concentrating on the move. Typical naughty puppy! Another one I will follow because he should come on nicely and just had that something about him. RBOB BP HAMILTONSTOVARE PG (1) 1 Adey's The Huntress From Sufayre Very workmanlike but rather unsettled at first. Good clean outline. Good length to head, Black nose with wide nostril Good straight well boned front, straight back and nicely angulated hindquarters. Nice reach and drive. RBOB

O 1 Adey's Abon Sfora Nordowskiej Knieji Handsome male with super head, calm expression, long muscled neck, good layback of shoulder, straight front good feet and tight elbow. Straight backed deep chest, Broad thigh and moved well with good length of stride. BOB

IRISH WOLFHOUND PG (3) 1 Spry's Killoughery Eclipse Powerful and well at herself as we say in Scotland. Maturing well. Correct head, Deep muzzle strong neck, well boned and well built. Chest still to drop but that is just time. Moved well although front right was slightly down on pastern but again this will surely improve once able to be exercised fully. 2 Leigh's Rycol Niamh at Mocharafior (IKC) these were littermates and not so mature. Growing these large breeds takes such care. They are still to develop in bone and deepen in chest. Not so confident on the surface so did not stride out as well but need time. 3 Leigh's Rycol Dylan at Mocharafior (IKC) O (1) 1 Spry's Killoughery Touchstone. Strong upstanding male with great bone. Super head and eye. Deep muzzle. Good depth of body, excellent coat Straight front large padded feet, broad thigh, low hocks used well on the move. Balanced overall. Covered the ground with ease using a long loping stride. BOB GP1 A pleasure to judge.

NORWEGIAN ELKHOUND PG (1) 1 McMahon's Seasara Kerfuffle Lovely Puppy. Excellent head, confident expression, Well constructed throughout with good straight front. Neat elbow, deep rib. Powerful neck Firm hindquarters. Moved well on good feet and strode out confidently. BOB BP. O (1) 1 McMahon's Frigg of North via Seasara (Imp Pol) Standing presented a nice outline. Good head, short neck good shoulders. Used ears well. On the move was less composed and was a touch wide coming towards me. RBOB.

WHIPPET P (7, 1) 1 Stephens Electric Paws Lambada at Jasteal (Imp Pol) Feminine brindle, lean head, dark eye, small ears, long neck, straight front, deep ribs, nicely ,

boned, shapely outline and stood over plenty ground BP. PG4 2 Laws & Pedley Biggins Viscar One Night Standards another with a lovely balance and shape. Stylish with a neat front good bone, lean head, dark eye, ears still to settle but a lot of prospect with this one. 3 Sharp's Saintharp All In Good Time. PG (8, 3) 1 Sharp's Barnesmore Never Feel Blue. Pleasing head with oval eye. Small ears. Good length of neck Plenty layback of shoulder. Straight front good feet, Shapely outline moved ok but at times slightly high steps – possibly the surface but overall very nice. 2 Little's Saintharp Can't Stop Me Now . Feminine and balanced. Tidy front well boned throughout deep ribs cuts up nicely. Good feet, Lost topline very slightly on the move but otherwise I liked her. 3 Durante' s Duranridge Chic Shadow.

OD (7) 1 Sharp's Saintharp Can't Get Enough Loved the head on this one. Lean and clean. Dark eye, Elegant neck Deep chest Straight front, Ribs were deep. Shapely outline on the move but a tendency to flatten standing. Good legs and feet. RBOB 2 Barnes Doddridge Silver Gigolo Mature male of good size. Good in front with elbow neatly tucked in. Well ribbed, good length, cuts up well behind ribs and with firm quarters. Moved ok. 3 Stephens Jastael Knight of Kynance

OB (6, 1) Barnes Leathern Thumbs Up for Doddridge. Such an elegant girl. Pleasing head Dark eye with calm expression, Small ears, Reachy neck, straight front good bone throughout and with good feet. Well angulated and on the move kept a slight curve to topline. Moved comfortably. BOB G2 2 Sharps Chippwhipp Georgy Porgy Many similar features as the winner and also well made with a good front and feet. Firm hindquarters. Moved ok. 3 Durante's Galemira 's Pandora of Duranridge

IMP REG O (2) 1 Gombas-Juhasz Bel Ch Vegas Des Vallees Longeronnaies Multi Jch (Basset Bleu) 2 Gombas-Juhasz Rom/Bel Ch Venise des Vallees Longeronnaies Hun/Int JCH (Basset Bleu) These two were very similar in certain features, both on the top height. Liked the heads on both and the fine ears, long necks. I preferred the length of back on the winner who kept his topline on the move. Second place was not so firm in topline which rose slightly.

AVNSC O (3,2) 1 Vargen's Ibizan Jeque La Princesa Rosa de Podi (Imp Svn) Long head with huge erect ears, Long neck, Short fronted with good straight legs, Flatter ribs, Short coupled and with moderate angulation behind. Covered ground well on his big feet.

AVH P (6,4) 1 P. Buckle Bunny (Beagle) 2 Urmston's Graigwith Maydream (Whippet)

G (7,1) 1 B Enchanted at Rubeusbay (Beagle) 2 Michelroy Boston Tea Party by Floridgebay (Beagle) 3 S Can't Stop Me Know (Whippet)

O (7,3) 1 Abon Sfora Nordowskief Kneiiji at Rubeusbay (Imp Pol) (Hamiltonstovare) 2 Galemira's Pandora of Duranridge (Whippet) 3 K Moon Hero (Min Smooth)

V (14, 4) 1 Livsey's Bryntreia Sea of Love (Whippet) Upstanding and fit. Well muscled throughout. Elegant outline. Clean head, Dark eyes, straight front and good feet. Curvy body, Good sweep of hindquarters to hock. Moved positively. 2 Hoopers Torbears Rare Magic (Whippet) 3 B Cupid at Janacop. (Min Wire Dachs)

CH (3.2) 1 Ch Dufosee Dragonfly of Parkebreeway JW.

RBOB STAKES 1 Saintharp Can't Get Enough (Whippet) 2. Parkebreeway Buckle Bunny (Beagle) 3 Raajput's Dancer Diva with Trisensara JW (Smooth Dachshund 4.

MELL COLEMAN PUPPY STAKES (31) This was a super class with lots of choice but my eye was taken by a powerful looking Dobermann. 1 Webb's Dobermann Shalissas Perfect Touch Elegant and well muscled. Long head with almond eye. Tight lips black nose. Small ears. Long neck good shoulder placement. Straight front Deep ribs. Well muscled hindquarters Moved out with ease covering the ground in style. 2 Mccammick's Golden Retriever Saffdales Countess Cora Such a feminine exhibit. Super head. Broad skull deep muzzle. Dark eye. Straight fronted, well boned broad hindquarters and well let down hocks Moved very well. Quite the picture with smiling expression and ever wagging tail. Plenty of coat. 3 Parkebreeway Buckle Bunny (Beagle)
